SENIOR EXAMINATION DIRECTIONS

- 1 It is particularly important to read the Examination Timetable carefully. No allowance will be made for candidates who do not attend an examination session because they misread the timetable.
- 2 You must sit for all your timetabled subject examinations, unless prevented by illness, accident or misadventure. Refer to the Assessment Booklet for procedures to follow.
- 3 You must wear full school uniform. Arrive at the examination venue not less than 15 minutes before the advertised starting time and check your allocated seating so that examinations can be started on time.
- 4 Students must not take into the examination room any paper, book, electronic device, headphones etc, other than a specified aid. Mobile phones, food and drinks (Water allowed) are not permitted inside the examination venue. Pencil cases, bags etc. should be placed as directed by the supervisor. Ensure Mobile Phones in bags are switched off!
- 5 You are required to obey any instruction given by a supervisor for the proper conduct of the examination. A mark of zero may be awarded to a student in a subject where examination rules have been broken.
- 6 Silence must be observed in the examination room. Behavioural issues will be classified as malpractice. Refer to the Assessment Booklet for procedures to follow.
- 7 Students may enter or leave an examination room only with the permission of a supervisor. No candidate will be re-admitted to the examination room unless he has been under approved supervision during the full period of his absence.
- 8 No student will be allowed to enter the examination room after the examination has been in progress for **thirty (30) minutes**. In this case the student must report to the Deputy Principal. No extra time will be allowed to students who arrive late.
- 9 You are required to stay for the full length of the examination.
- 10 Ten (10) minutes before the conclusion of the examination paper the supervisor will announce:
"There are ten minutes remaining."
- 11 At the end of the examination the supervisor will say "Stop work". On this instruction you must close your examination booklets immediately. Complete any details on the front of answer booklets if necessary. If a candidate is seen to be writing any other information after the "Stop work" instruction, his paper may be cancelled.
- 12 You must follow the instructions of the supervisor regarding the order in which to collate your papers. A signed record will be made of papers collected. There is to be no speaking until you have left the examination room.
